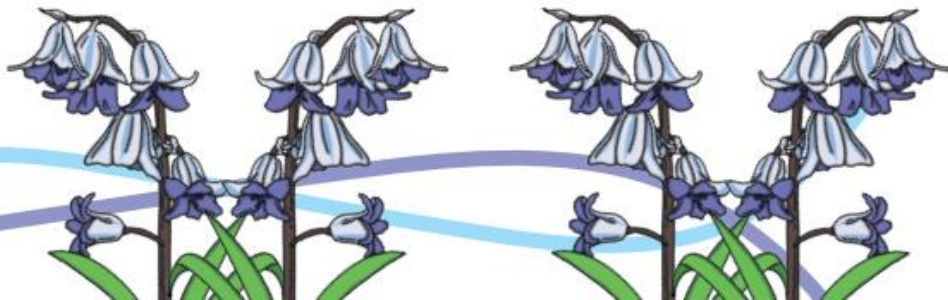
Bluebell Farm
