This morning we have all woken up to a new government and Prime Minister. We will wait to see what that means for education in the coming months. We had an assembly earlier in the week to explain in simple terms to the children, what happens in a general election to enable them to understand democracy within our country.

This week in reception, the children have been preparing for their end of year assembly. They are practising their performance and we look forward to seeing parents and grandparents at the assembly next Friday 12th July at 9.30am. Preschoolers are welcome to attend, we would just ask that you step outside for a few moments if they are interrupting the performance.

To support your child to embed this learning, which is part of the national curriculum, give them opportunities to handle money, recognise coins and understand the coins have different values.



As part of their transition programme, year 2 have been getting to know the adults in the junior school and are becoming familiar with their new school environment. This week they attended an assembly in the junior school and next week they will be spending one of their lunchtimes there.

Children in reception and year 1 will be spending time with their new teachers and in their new classroom next week.

Any changes to your child's meal choices are to be made by parents by <u>9am</u> <u>Wednesday's</u> for the following week to ensure that your child is getting their favourite choice, we appreciate that children can change their preferences. PLEASE NOTE: We are unable to accept late orders for meals, if you miss the deadline you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch that week.

If you need sessions for this current half term you will need to call to book and pay. **Please note that some** days are already full.

Medication

If your child has medication that needs to be held in school, this will come home with your child on the last day of term. If they require the medication to be administered in school for the next academic year you will need to bring it to the office, <u>in its original packaging</u> and complete fresh forms for the year. Please ensure that the medication has not expired. If there are updated medical care plans relating to your child, please also bring these in to the office.

Pierced Ears—Reminder!

Children may wear stud earrings in school. Hoops and other earrings are not permitted for safety reasons.

If you are considering getting your child's ears pierced, please bear in mind that children are not permitted to wear earrings during PE/after school clubs and tape is not allowed. We recommend having them pierced in the 6 weeks holiday.

Children may wear a wrist watch in school if they are learning to tell time (analogue). We recommend not to wear high value watches in case they were to get lost or damaged. No other jewellery should be worn in school.

Safeguarding—end of day pick up IMPORTANT

If your child is going home with a different adult who is not on your approved regular contacts, please inform your child's class teacher that morning or please call or email the office. Your child will not be released unless we have received your permission.

Birthday's

Children are welcome to bring in sweets or birthday party invitations to hand out to their friends if it is their birthday. This will need to be done in the playground before or after school though when their parents are present. Please be mindful that some children may have allergies. Staff are unable to do this task on your child's behalf.
