# Get started with your learning

#### **Children moving into Year 1:**

know all the sounds of the alphabet and be able to read and write simple CVC words.

Count, read and write numbers to 20

#### **Children moving into Year 2:**

count up in 2's, 5's and 10's, spell the days of the week and months of the year, name the street, city and country that you live in.
