Lost Property

We will be displaying our lost property outside by the gates. Please ensure to have a look if you think you have lost anything. Anything remaining in the boxes on the last day of term will be recycled.

Medication

If your child has medication that needs to be held in school, this will come home with your child on the last day of term. If they require the medication to be administered in school for the next academic year you will need to bring it **to the office**, in its **original packaging** and complete fresh forms for the year. Please ensure that the medication has not expired. If there are updated medical care plans relating to your child, please also bring these in to the office.

Pierced Ears—Reminder!

Children may wear stud earrings in school. **Hoops and other earrings are not permitted for safety reasons.**

If you are considering getting your child's ears pierced, please bear in mind that children are not permitted to wear earrings during PE/after school clubs and tape is not allowed. We recommend having them pierced in the **6 weeks holiday**. Children may wear a wrist watch in school if they are learning to tell time (analogue). We recommend not to wear high value watches in case they were to get lost or damaged. No other jewellery should be worn in school.
