

## Support for prickly spellings

In the Year 2 Spelling units, the remaining Phase 5 tricky words are called prickly spellings. This document provides support for teaching all of the prickly spellings.

Unit	Prickly spelling	Why is it prickly?	How to teach
1	<u>o</u> nce	The grapheme 'o' makes the sounds <b>w-u</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'o'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>w-u</b> .
	tw <u>o</u>	The grapheme 'wo' makes the sound oo (as in 'food'). This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'wo'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says oo.
2	<u>a</u> ny	The grapheme 'a' makes the sound <b>e</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'a'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>e</b> .
	ma <u>n</u> y	The grapheme 'a' makes the sound <b>e</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'a'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>e</b> .
4	<u>wh</u> o	The word 'who' has two tricky parts: the digraph 'wh' makes the sound <b>h</b> and the grapheme 'o' makes the sound oo (as in 'food'). These are rare GPCs.	Point to 'wh'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>h</b> . Point to 'o'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says oo.
	<u>wh</u> ole	The digraph 'wh' makes the sound <b>h</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'wh'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>h</b> .
5	pe <u>o</u> ple	The digraph 'eo' makes the sound <b>ee</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'eo'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>ee</b> .
	fr <u>i</u> end	The digraph 'ie' makes the sound <b>e</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'ie'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>e</b> .
6	mo <u>o</u> ve	The grapheme 'o' makes the sound oo (as in 'food'). This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'o'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says oo.
	impr <u>o</u> ve	The grapheme 'o' makes the sound oo (as in 'food'). This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'o'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says oo.
8	be <u>au</u> tiful	The trigraph 'eau' makes the sound <b>yoo</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'eau'. <b>Say:</b> This trigraph says <b>yoo</b> .
	la <u>u</u> gh	The word 'laugh' has two tricky parts: the digraph 'au' makes the sound <b>ar</b> or <b>a</b> (depending on regional pronunciation) and the digraph 'gh' makes the sound <b>f</b> *. *This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'au'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>ar</b> or <b>a</b> . This digraph says <b>a</b> . Point to 'gh'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>f</b> .
9	bu <u>u</u> y	The grapheme 'u' makes the sound <b>i</b> .	Point to 'u'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>i</b> .
	pre <u>e</u> tt <u>y</u>	The grapheme 'e' makes the sound <b>i</b> . This is a rare GPC in the middle of a word.	Point to 'e'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>i</b> .
10	pa <u>ar</u> ents	The digraph 'ar' makes the sound <b>air</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'ar'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>air</b> .
	beca <u>au</u> se	The digraph 'au' makes the sound <b>o</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'au'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>o</b> .
12	<u>eye</u>	The trigraph 'eye' makes the sound <b>igh</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'eye'. <b>Say:</b> This trigraph says <b>igh</b> .
	sh <u>oe</u>	The digraph 'oe' makes the sound oo (as in 'food'). This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'oe'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says oo.
13	th <u>ough</u>	The grapheme 'ough' makes the sound <b>or</b> . This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'ough'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>or</b> .
	th <u>oo</u> gh	The grapheme 'ough' makes the sound oo (as in 'food'). This is a rare GPC.	Point to 'ough'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says oo.
