Reception children have settled well into school routines. Many of them are confidently finding their way around school and those who need it are being supported by our year 2 children, who are escorting them at lunchtimes. Well done year 2 children for being so responsible and helpful.

Thank you to all the parents who attended the recent year group meetings. It is a good opportunity to find out more about the expectations for your child's year group and how you can help them at home. In reception this week the children have started their phonics lessons. Please remember to have a look at Tapestry, where teachers will be adding wow moments to your child's portfolio. Parents are also invited to upload photographs of their child's achievements to share with school.

Year 1 children have been using Michael Rosen's well known story book as their English text. The children have been recreating their own bear hunt and retelling the story. The children have also been looking at toys from the past in their History lessons.





Children in year 2 have been learning the names of the 7 continents and 5 oceans. Recalling this information on a regular basis helps them to retain it in their long-term memory. They have learnt a song that they can sing to you at home to help them remember the continents.

This afternoon we have the first PSA event of the year, our PSA fun walk and what a great day it is for this event.

Is your child due to start school in September 2026?


