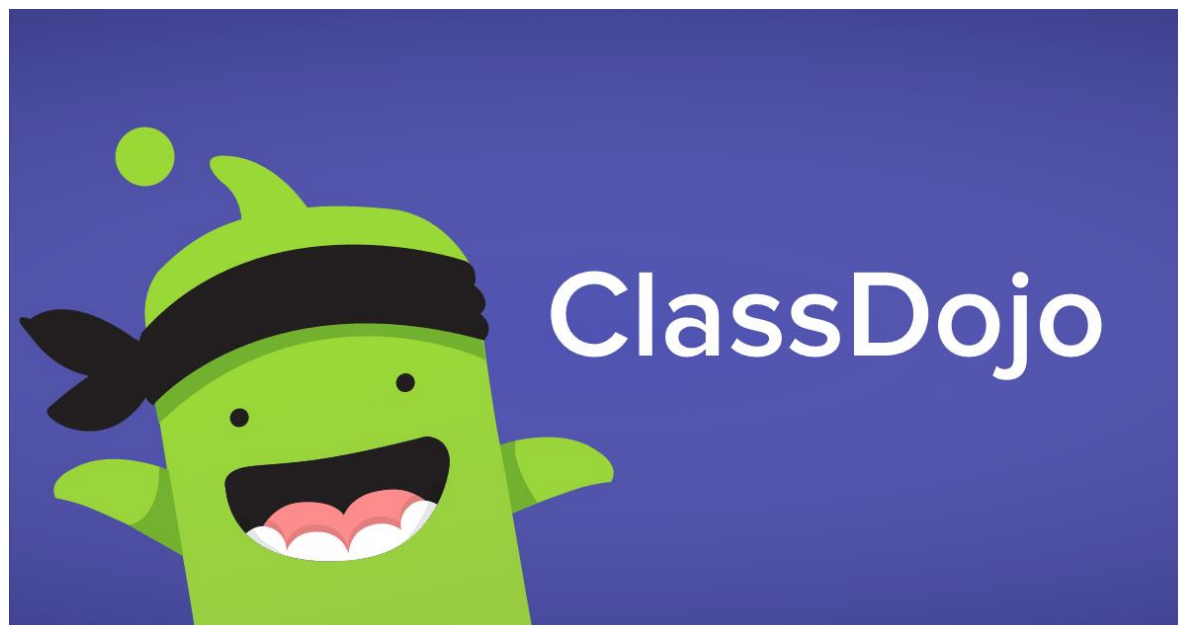

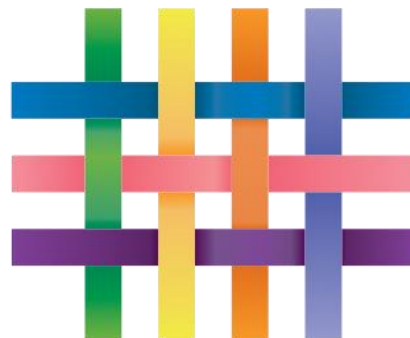

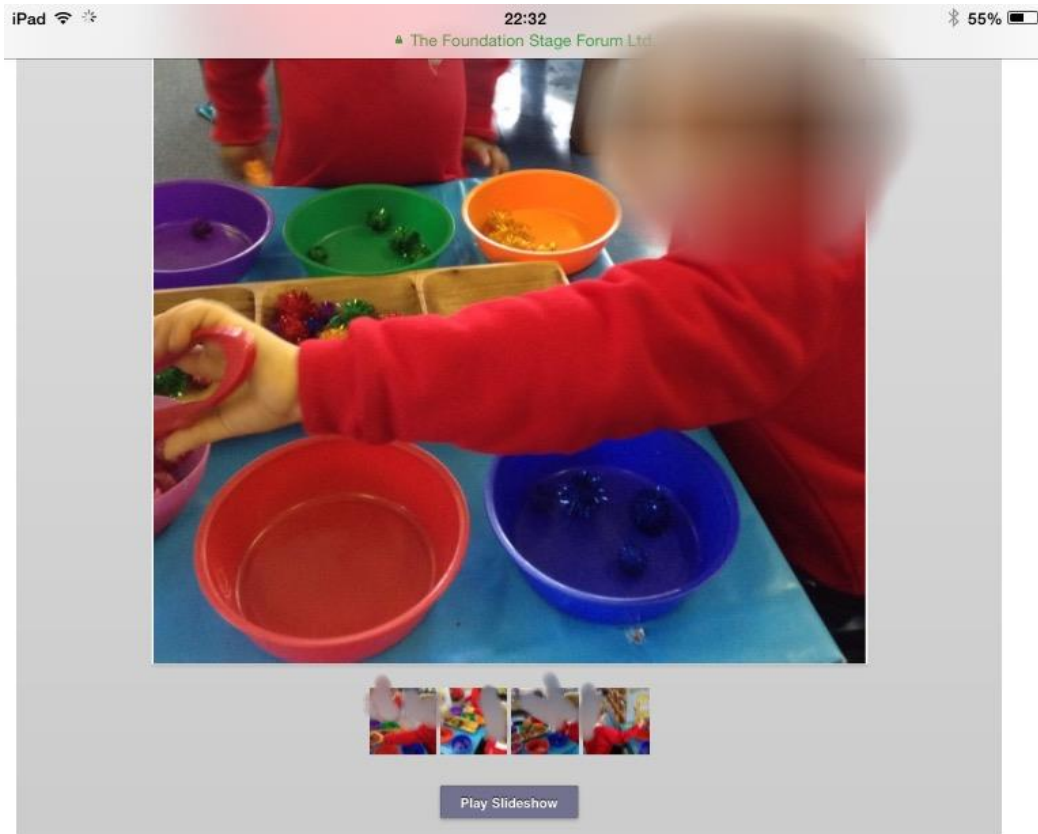

From Thursday 12th September 2024 children will be in school full time:

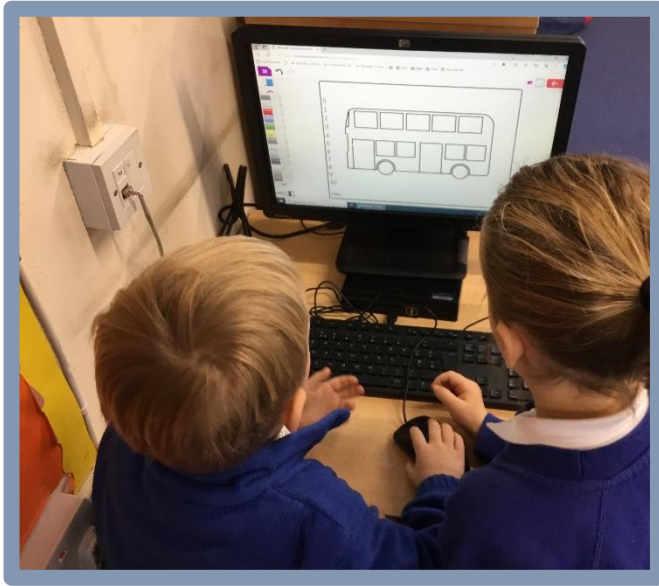
