This morning the children learnt the message about speaking out to stay safe from the NSPCC. We explored the range of safe adults in and out of school children could talk to if they were worried about something. Please reinforce this message at home to give children the confidence to talk about things that are worrying them. Next week is children's mental health week and our assemblies will

be focused on the theme, "Know yourself, Grow yourself." This is all about how we can build and grow our resilience by understanding ourselves and recognising our emotions.

In their gymnastics lessons this week, children in reception have been learning about parts of their body they can balance on. Children have been demonstrating how they can hold their balance by controlling their body.





In their history lesson, year 1 have been learning about Mary Anning. The children have been finding out how we use evidence to find out about the past. The children have been thinking carefully about which evidence would have been available from 200 years ago.

As part of their geography lessons, Year 2 children have been investigating where in the world our food comes from and why. The children used atlases to find the countries stated on food labels and identify what the climate may be like in that country based on their previous knowledge.

Thank you to the PSA for all their organisation and preparation for the school disco today. We have lots of excited children in school and I'm sure we will all have a great time.

Parent consultations take place on **Thursday 6th February 3.20-430pm** and **Thursday 13th February 4.20-7.30pm**.


If you are unable to make your appointment please ensure to let your child's class teacher know so that they can continue with the next appointment.
