Reminders regarding school site safety

- * Adults/Children of all ages should be dismounting bikes or scooters before they enter the gates of our school site. Scooters and bikes can be stored in the bike shed provided.
- * The play equipment in the playground should not be used by anyone during drop off and pick up times as per the sign on the main gates. Please ensure that this is fed back to other adults who drop off and collect your child, such as grandparents.
- * Vaping and smoking is not permitted anywhere on our school site at any time.
- * Dogs are not permitted within the school site at anytime, this includes the carrying of dogs too. Service dogs are an exception to this.
- *Please ensure that you and your child do not walk through the staff carpark to access the school. There are access gates by the infant and the junior school side which provide a safer route.
- *Parking—If you drive to and from school, parking is prohibited on the double yellow lines and the single yellow line at restricted times in hall close, this is to ensure the safety of pedestrians. Please park considerately when parking on residential roads. Traffic wardens regularly patrol the area.

If your child is signed up to a sports or active club, please ensure that if your child wears earring that they are not worn on the day of the club. They will also need suitable clothing to change into for the relevant club.

All clubs finish at **4.15pm**. Collection from clubs is from the main entrance to the school. The club provider will hand children over one by one once their adult is visible. If someone else is collecting your child, please ensure that you have notified the school office.
