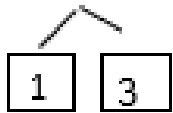


Friday 28th November 2025 Maths Homework

$$66 + 7 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$



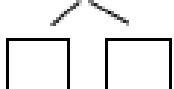
