### **School Attendance**

Our school attendance target is 97%.

This half term our attendance is 96%


95 pupils currently have 100% attendance.

Punctuality is important. Children need to be in school for register at 8.45am. If your child is late to school, parents are required to sign them in at the office and to record the reason for lateness.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: Earrings cannot be worn on PE days or if your child attends a club, unless the child can remove them themselves. Staff are not permitted to remove or tape earrings.



Please ensure that your child does not bring any products into school containing nuts, including cereal bars, cakes and sandwich fillings etc.
