### **School Attendance**

Our school attendance target is 97% Attendance this academic year so far: 94.9% Reception: 93.6% Year 1: 95.8% Year 2: 94.9%

15 children have received certificates today for 100% attendance. Well done.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: Earrings cannot be worn on PE days or if your child attends a club, unless the child can remove them themselves. Staff are not permitted to remove or tape earrings. Parents will be called if the child cannot remove them.
