Our menu will then change after Easter and meals for that period will need to be booked on PARENT PAY, our new payment system. YOU MUST ACTIVATE YOUR PARENT PAY ACCOUNT! Reminders have been sent to those parents that have not yet done this. You will not be able to order meals unless this is done.

Reminder: If your child has a meal ordered and they arrive with a packed lunch, they will be given the meal and the packed lunch will come home with them.

Any changes to pre-ordered meal choices are to be made by parents by no later than **9am Wednesday's** for the following week to ensure your child is getting their favourite choice, we appreciate children can change their minds.

We are unable to accept late orders as we only order enough ingredients based on pre-orders to limit food wastage, you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch if the deadline is missed.
