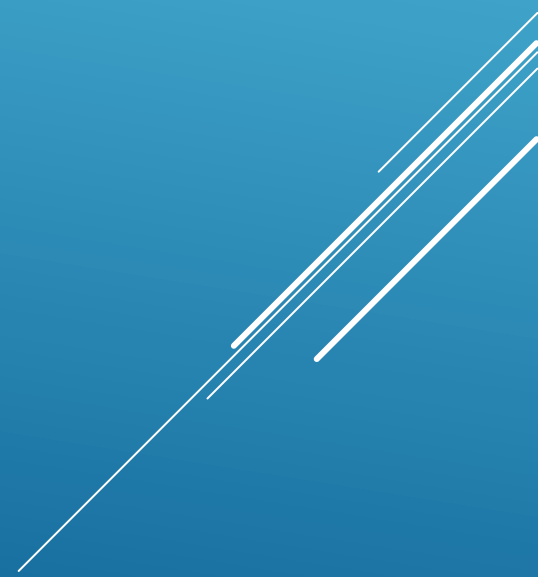
TIMETABLE

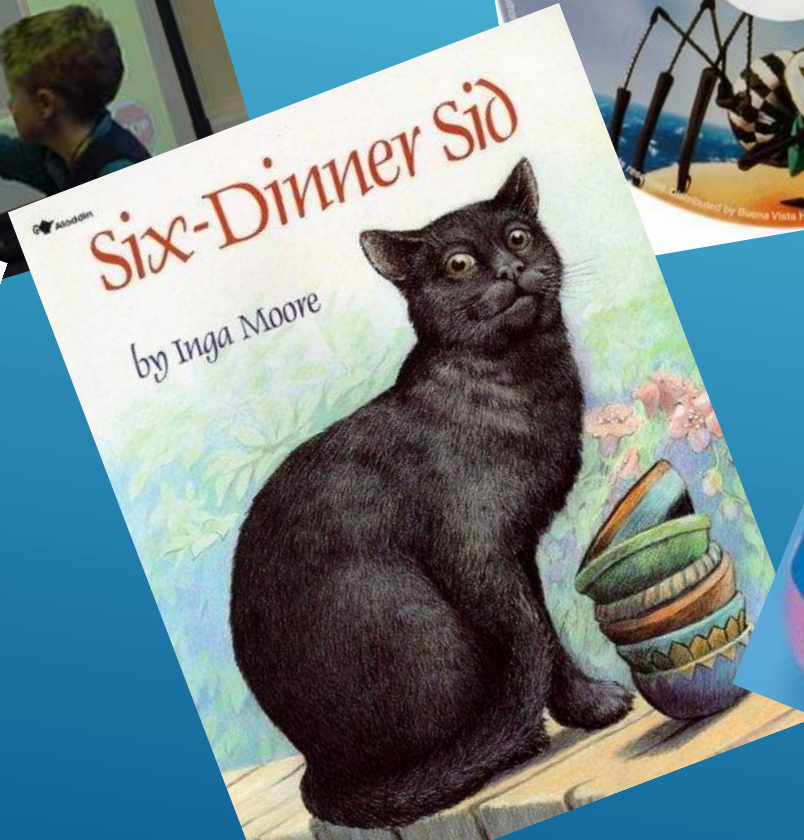
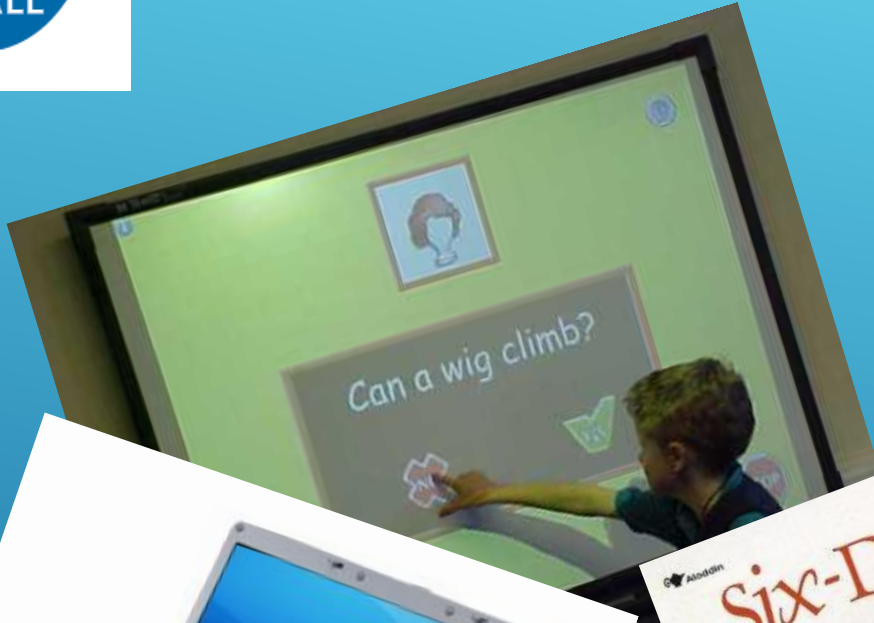
Phonics

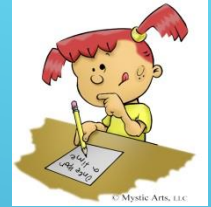

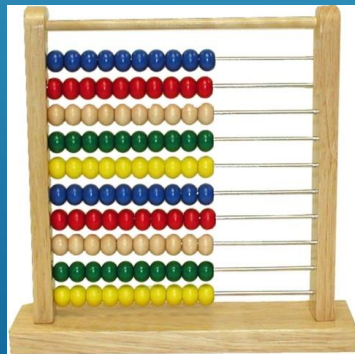

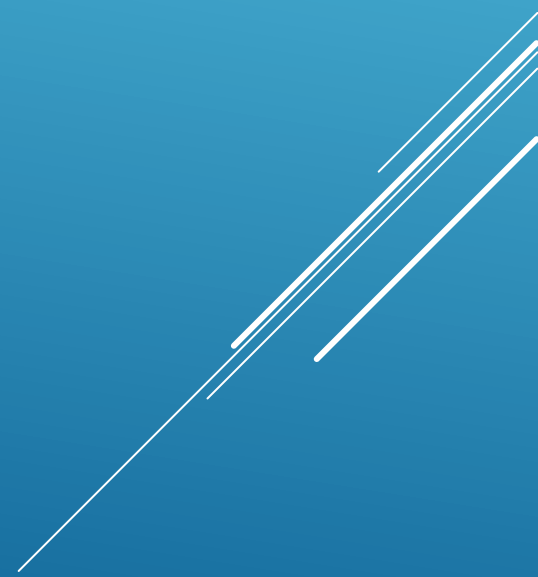
SATs Assessments at the end of KS1 are no longer statutory .
