Get started with your learning

Start to practise and learn skills you will need in your new year group. Here are some ideas:

Children moving into Year 1:

know all the sounds of the alphabet and be able to read and write simple CVC words.

Count, read and write numbers to 20

Children moving into Year 2:

count up in 2's, 5's and 10's, spell the days of the week and months of the year, name the street, city and country that you live in.
