They need help to work out the different ways they have made 7 on their washing lines. Count how many items are on the top line and write that in the first box. Then count how many are on the bottom line and write that in the second box. How many are there altogether? Some of the boxes have been completed already to help you. Can you check that they got it right?

If you do not have a printer at home, do not worry! You could look at the pictures on a screen and either draw them yourself in the homework book or you could just write the number sentences in the homework book instead.

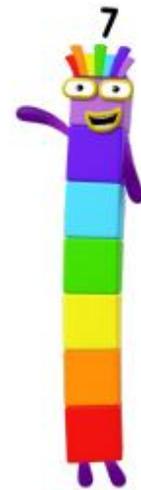
Parents:
