### **English**

#### Phonics and spelling:

Taught in daily lessons using Little Wandle Revised Letters and Sounds planning and resources.

#### Grammar and Punctuation:

Taught throughout each text type, as appropriate. Focus this half term on conjunctions and types of sentences.

#### Reading

The children will take part in group reading sessions twice a week.

#### Literature based approach

We will read a range of texts during our topic. During these lessons the children will retell stories, write letters and write about real events.

#### Handwriting

Children will be taught how to join their letters following the Nelson programme.

# Music

# <u>How does music make the world a better</u> place?

During their work in Music the children will be learning to sing the song 'hands, feet and heart'. They will also learn how to play tuned instruments to accompany their singing. At the end of their work they will perform the song. The children will begin to develop their improvisation skills.

# PE

#### Street dance

The children will enjoy being taught Street Dance from a specialist dance teacher. They will learn a range of moves and perform these to music.

## Sending and receiving

During outdoor PE lessons the children will develop their sending and receiving skills.

# Mathematics

#### Number: Multiplication and Division

Multiplying and dividing, including remainders, using arrays and solving problems. The children will learn their 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

The children will also revisit their prior learning of the continents and oceans.

The children will be developing their painting and printing skills.
