- ▶ Homework is posted on the school website on a Friday and needs to be completed by Wednesday. Please send a photo on Class Dojo.

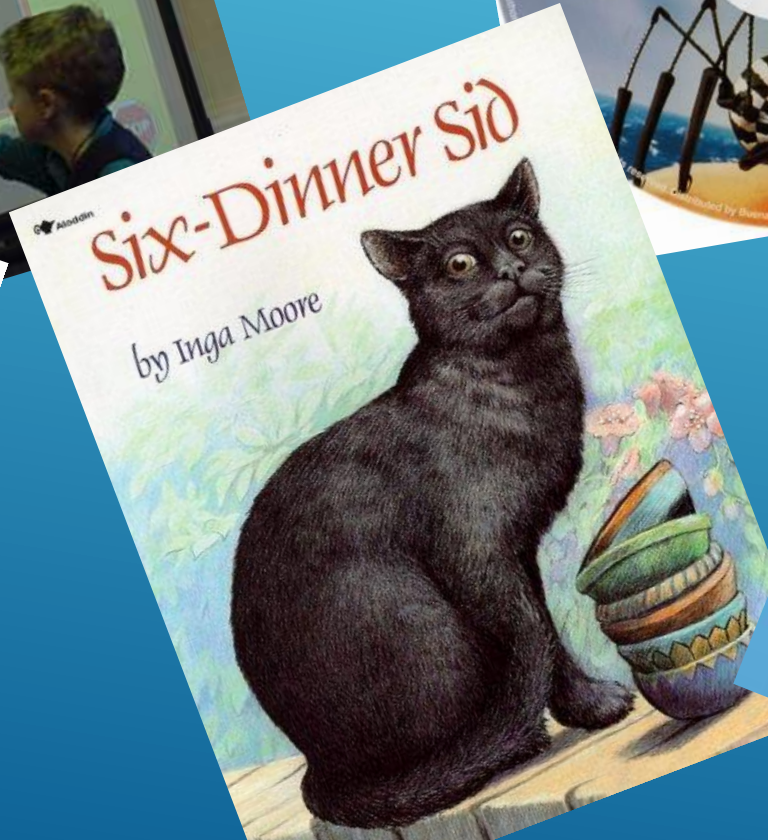
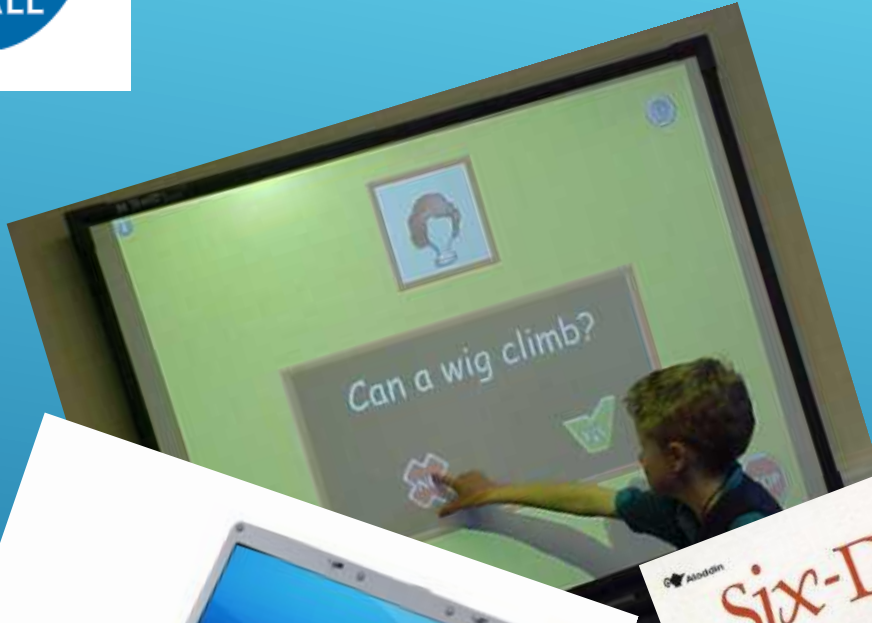
Phonics

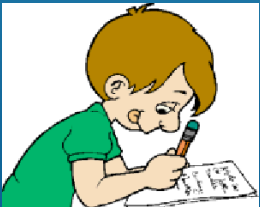

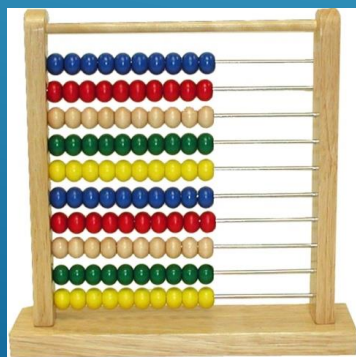

If your child is in an infant school

If your child is in year 2 at an Essex infant school, you can apply for a September 2024 year 3 (junior school) place between 6 November 2023 and 15 January 2024.

If you live in the Essex County Council area, but your child is at an infant school outside Essex, you need to contact the school's local authority or speak to your child's current school to find out how to apply for a year 3 school place.
