Please ensure to click <u>PAY</u> on the app to ensure that the meals are sent through to us. (all infant school children receive Universal Free School Meals).

Please note that if your child has a meal ordered and they arrive with a packed lunch, they will be given the meal and the packed lunch will come home with them. This helps to cut down on food wastage.

Please ensure that any changes to your child's meal choices are made by Wednesday's for the following week to ensure that your child is getting their favourite choice, we appreciate that children can change their preferences.

Medical Appointments

If you are having to take your child out of school for medical or dental appointments, please ensure to provide proof of these appointments to the office. This can either be by showing us a hospital letter or text reminder. This can either be brought to the office or you can email us a clear screenshot of it. Where possible, please book dental appointments out of school hours.

Time off for illness

Just a reminder that if your child is unwell and unable to attend the school, please ensure to let the office know either by telephone or email by 9am on the first day of absence. Please state your child's first and last name, class number and the reason for absence (ie has a temperature, please don't simply state unwell). If your child has sickness or diarrhea, they will need to remain off school for 48hours from the last instance.

Stikins

If you are needing name labels for your child's uniform, water bottles etc we recommend Stikins. If you do order from them, please quote our fundraising number **1081** as the school will receive a small commission for each order placed.
