# Our school attendance target is 97%

Attendance this academic year so far: 95% Reception: 93.7% Year 1: 95.8% Year 2: 95.2%

We are seeing an increase in parents contacting the office via email to inform us their child is on holiday. A referral for a penalty notice will still be completed in these instances. A reminder that forms should be completed.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: Earrings cannot be worn on PE days or if your child attends a club, unless the child can remove them themselves. Staff are not permitted

to remove or tape earrings. Parents will be called if the child cannot remove them. Please ensure that your child does not bring any products into school containing

nuts, including cereal bars, cakes and sandwich fillings. This includes chocolate spread as we cannot be sure that it is not Nutella. We have staff and children with severe nut allergies.
