Activity:

In school, we have been learning about technology and how to stay safe on the internet. We read a story about internet safety and what to do if something appears on the screen that we do not like or if we do not know what to do. The story told us: Before you tap and click, you need to stop and think, and tell someone. We have also looked at using the internet to find out information with a grown up. As a class, we looked up information about Burkina Faso in Africa.

For your homework this week, we would like you to find technology around your house (this can include washing machines, remote control toys and TVs). Take a few photos of the examples of technology that you find (5 maximum). Whilst you are searching around your house for technology, can you talk to your grown up about how to stay safe when using the internet on different devices?
