In reception, children have been finding out about life cycles. Thanks to funding from the PSA the children have been able to observe ducklings hatch from eggs over the past two weeks and

They have even witnessed the ducklings first swim.



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Year 1 children have been learning about maps in geography. The children have been drawing their own maps of part of the school grounds, thinking about symbols they could use to represent objects.

As part of their learning in design and technology, children in year 2 are focusing on food technology this half term. The children will be making their own pizza but in preparation for this they have looked at market research on favourite pizza toppings, taste tested a range of toppings themselves and looked at the process of making a pizza. The children are certainly excited about making and eating their own.

One of the areas on our school development plan for this year is oracy; developing the children's active listening and speaking skills. The advances in technology have meant as adults we are spending less time communicating out loud and doing more silent online communication. We would encourage parents to spend some quality 'talk time' with children to support them in developing these skills. School Attendance

Please ensure to click <u>**PAY**</u> on the School Money app to ensure meals are sent through to us.

If your child has a meal ordered and they arrive with a packed lunch, they will be given the meal and the packed lunch will come home with them.

Any changes to pre-ordered meal choices are to be made by parents by no later than **<u>9am Wednesday's</u>** for the following week to ensure your child is getting their favourite choice, we appreciate children can change their minds.

We are unable to accept late orders as we only order enough ingredients based on pre-orders to limit food wastage, you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch if the deadline is missed.

You will have all received your activation letters via email this week for Parent Pay. This will be used to order meals from our new menu which starts after Easter. We will notify you when you can start ordering these meals.
