

Reception Homework – Friday 21st November

Please complete this week's homework by taking pictures for Tapestry. You can use the paper in your homework book if you would like. Please give it the title: Homework 21.11.2025.

Activity:

This week, we would like you to draw a picture of a person in the community that helps us. This could be a shop keeper, librarian, vet, dentist, hairdresser, postal worker, builder or someone else. Can you then write the initial sound for the person that you have drawn (e.g. h for hairdresser or b for builder)? You could even label some of the tools or equipment they need to do their job with the initial sounds too (e.g. s for scissors or b for bag).

Ideas for parents:

- Support your child with the correct pencil grip.
- Talk to your child about the person they have drawn and how they help us.
- Support your child with hearing the initial sound(s) if needed.
- You could challenge your child to segment (break up) the whole word and write the phonemes (sounds) they hear if it is a simple three letter word like 'pad' for a pad of paper.
- Please make sure your child is only writing the initial sound **or** a simple three letter word that they can segment.
- Use the formation phrase (see document on website under the homework) to support with the formation of the graphemes (letters).
