Seaside in the Past – History Off The Page

As a way of providing your child with the best opportunity to learn about The Seaside in the Past, we have arranged History off the Page to spend the day with year 1 on **Tuesday 16th June 2026**. History off the Page is a company that provides immersive and practical History, Science and Literature workshops to schools.

On this day, your child will be given hands on experience with a range of seaside artefacts and memorabilia from the past. There will be a creative session where they will learn about the different types of amusements, which were popular in the past.

It would help the children engage with their learning if they are dressed in seaside clothes. Such as shorts and t-shirts and summer dresses (no crop tops or sandals please).

In the afternoon, the children will visit the 'pier' and there will be a Punch & Judy show.

We do need a small number of adult helpers during the day. If you think you would be available to help for either the morning or afternoon sessions, please let your child's class teacher know by **Friday 6th June**.

Overall cost: £726.90
Funding from the PSA: £266.90

In order to cover costs, we ask for a contribution of **£10.00** per child which is payable via Parent Pay. This needs to be done please by **Friday 15th May 2026**.

We are always looking into ways to ensure that every child in school has the opportunity to attend or participate in events and school trips. With all trips and events that require a contribution from parents, we only ever ask for a contribution to cover the costs involved, calculated for each child.

On Parent Pay we have opened up a payment option where parents can donate to a fund which will be used to help support children in school, whose family are struggling financially. This payment option remains open during the school year and parents may contribute as little or as much as they wish as often as they like.

The fund is called 'Every Child an Opportunity' and parents are not obligated to contribute to this fund.
