School Attendance and Punctuality

Our attendance this term to date is 97.7%

This is a fantastic start to the term, thank you to parents for making sure your child attends school each day and on time.

School starts at 8.45am

If your child is late, you will need to bring them to the office and sign them in. Your child will be marked as late if they arrive between 8.45am and 9.15am and unauthorised for the session if they arrive after 9.15am once registers close.



Please ensure that your child does not bring any products into school containing nuts, including cereal bars, cakes and sandwich fillings etc. This also includes chocolate spread as we cannot be sure that it is not Nutella. We have staff and children with severe nut allergies. Thank you



Click on the School Money icon above to book your child's dinners. Orders must be placed by: 9am Wednesday 20th September for week commencing 25th September 2023.

Please ensure to click PAY on the app to ensure that the meals are sent through to us. (all infant school children receive Universal Free School Meals). The current menu will continue until the October Half Term.

Please note that if your child has a meal ordered and they arrive with a packed lunch, they will be given the meal and the packed lunch will come home with them. This helps to cut down on food wastage.

Please ensure that any changes to your child's meal choices are made by Wednesday's for the following week to ensure that your child is getting their favourite choice, we appreciate that children can change their preferences.



Breakfast Club Reminder Please do not send your child to Breakfast Club if they are not booked in. If you are in need of occasional adhoc sessions you will need to call the office to book and pay for the sessions that you need. Please ensure that if you intend to pay for sessions with childcare vouchers that plenty of time is given before each booking window


opens so that the funds can clear in time.

Extra-Curricular Clubs

The Autumn Term clubs will be starting from **Monday 18th September**. All clubs are to be booked and paid for as usual, directly with the club providers. Their flyers, as well as the timetable, can be found under the parents tab on our website. Please ensure that your child brings in suitable clothing to wear for their club if it is not on their PE day and that earrings are removed that day.





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Uniform, Water Bottles, Lunch Boxes

Please ensure that school uniform, including shoes and hats, are clearly labelled with the child's name for the staff and your child to easily identify their items. Lunch boxes should also be clearly named. Book bags may have <u>one</u> small keyring so that the bags fit in your child's drawer or book bag box in the classroom.

Birthday sweets and invitations

If it is your child's birthday and they want to hand out sweets or invitations to a party, we ask that children do this before or after school in the playground. The staff are unable to provide assistance with this and if any sweets or invitations are given to staff they will be given back to the parent.

Stikins

If you are needing name labels for your child's uniform, water bottles etc we recommend Stikins. If you do order from them, please quote our fundraising number **1081** as the school will receive a small commission for each order placed.

Pupil Premium Funding

If your circumstances have recently changed and you are in receipt of the benefits listed below, the school may be able to apply for additional funding for your child. If you think that this could apply to you, please email us at admin@baddowhall-inf.essex.sch.uk including the child's name, your first and last name and your national insurance number. We may need to ask you to provide further proof that you are receiving the relevant benefits listed.

you are receiving the relevant benefits listed. Free school meals are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, one or more of the following benefits:

 * Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned of no more than $\pounds7,400$, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods).

- * Income support
- * Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- * Income based Jobseeker's Allowance
- * Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- * The guarantee element of Pension Credit

 * Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
* Working Tax Credit run-on—paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for

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Please let us know as soon as possible as we need to have applied for funding before our next Census which is in October.

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
