In maths this week we have been learning about division by sharing and grouping. For homework we would like the children to:

1. Practise counting in 2s to 50, 5s and 10s to 100.
2. Read the sharing problems below. Children can draw dots to share or use objects. It is important that children know that to share fairly the groups need to be equal (the same amount).
3. Star challenge on page 2 if children would like to complete.

Tim has 16 bananas.

He shares them equally between two boxes.

How many bananas are in each box?

Sarah has 15 Barbie's.

She shares them equally between 5 friends.

How many Barbie's do they get each?

Bob has 25 sweets.

He shares them equally between 5 friends.

How many sweets do they get each?

Amy has 20 flowers.

She shares them equally between 10 pots.

How many flowers in each pot?

A bird has 12 seeds.

It shares them equally between 2 birds.

How many seeds do they get each?

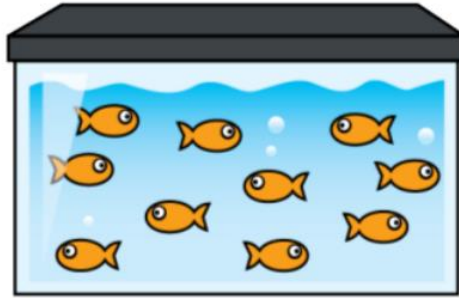
Noi has 6 cats.

How many cats do they have each?

She puts them into some bowls.

There are the same number of fish in each bowl.

How many bowls could she use?
