
Baddow Hall Infants, who have the best interests of the children at the heart of everything they do. They certainly deserve their summer holiday after a successful school year.

Congratulations to those children who are on track to achieve 100% attendance for the academic year.

Earrings: If you intend to have your child's ears pierced, this needs 6 weeks to heal. Please schedule this for the beginning of the holidays as they will need to remove earrings for PE lessons in September.

Medication:


All medication will be sent home at the end of term.
