Dear Families.

Yesterday, year 2 performed at the Chelmsford Infant Music Festival. The children performed alongside other schools singing, playing instruments and acting together. The children had a great afternoon and the performance was enjoyed by all. Well done year 2.

In reception this week, the children have been learning about and exploring how to sort objects in maths. The children have been looking carefully at the objects and using new vocabulary to describe the properties, enabling them to sort into different groups.

Year 1 children have been learning about measuring in maths. The children have been using the balance scales to compare the weight of different objects, as well as, finding things that are taller and shorter around the classroom.



As we approach the last week of the spring term, just a few reminders about next week. If the weather is kind to us next Friday, we will have our Easter bonnet parade in the playground and parents will be invited to attend at 9.00am. Reminder: If your child has a meal ordered and they arrive with a packed lunch, they will be given the meal and the packed lunch will come home with them.

Any changes to pre-ordered meal choices are to be made by parents by no later than **9am Wednesday's** for the following week to ensure your child is getting their favourite choice, we appreciate children can change their minds.

We are unable to accept late orders as we only order enough ingredients based on pre-orders to limit food wastage, you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch if the deadline is missed.

Please be aware that seating is limited in the church. We would need a number of parent helpers for each class to assist with walking the children to the church and back to school. If you are able to do this, please let your child's class teacher know by **Friday 28th March**.
