Dear Parents/Carers,

This week we have had a number of parents raising concern about how cars have been parked before and after school. Please be reminded that the single lines in Hall Close have time restrictions. Those without a blue badge should not be parking on the double yellow lines. We ask that parents put child safety first and be considerate about where you park. Thank you.





In reception this week, children have been reading 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'A Place Called Home' by Kate Baker and Rebecca Green .The children have been thinking about different types of houses from around the world and talking about the similarities and differences. As the children are out and about, help them to develop their speech and language by talking about the different homes you can see on your journeys.

In year 1, children have been using an empty number line in Maths lessons to help them with ordering numbers and to have a visual representation. This is a strategy that will support them moving towards mental calculations.





Year 2 children have been thinking about why light is an important symbol for Christians, Jews and Hindus. They have compared the similarities and differences for each religion. They have also been exploring how darkness and light makes us feel.

The Autumn disco tickets are for sale on school money for year 1 and 2. Children in reception will have an opportunity to experience the disco before school ends on Friday. Year 1 and 2 can bring some 'disco' clothes to change into at the end of day. Children should be collected from their classroom at 4.20pm.
