Reporting absence

If your child will be absent from school you must call or email by 9.30am. When calling or emailing, please ensure that you include the following information:

- Child's first and last name
- Class number (or name of teacher)
- Reason for absence

Please note that if your child has been sick or has diarrhea, they must remain off school for 48 hours from the last instance. This is to help prevent the spread of potential bugs.

Please ensure that your child does not bring any products into school containing nuts, including cereal bars, cakes and sandwich fillings.

This includes chocolate spread as we cannot be sure that it is not Nutella. We have staff and children with severe nut allergies.

Order your child's school dinners

Please book your child's meals in advance.

Meals for the week beginning 15th December must be booked by midnight on Tuesday 9th December 2025. Wednesday 17th ParentPay December is our Christmas dinner so make sure to book!



If a meal is not booked, reminders are not sent out so parents will be phoned and asked to provide their child with a packed lunch.
