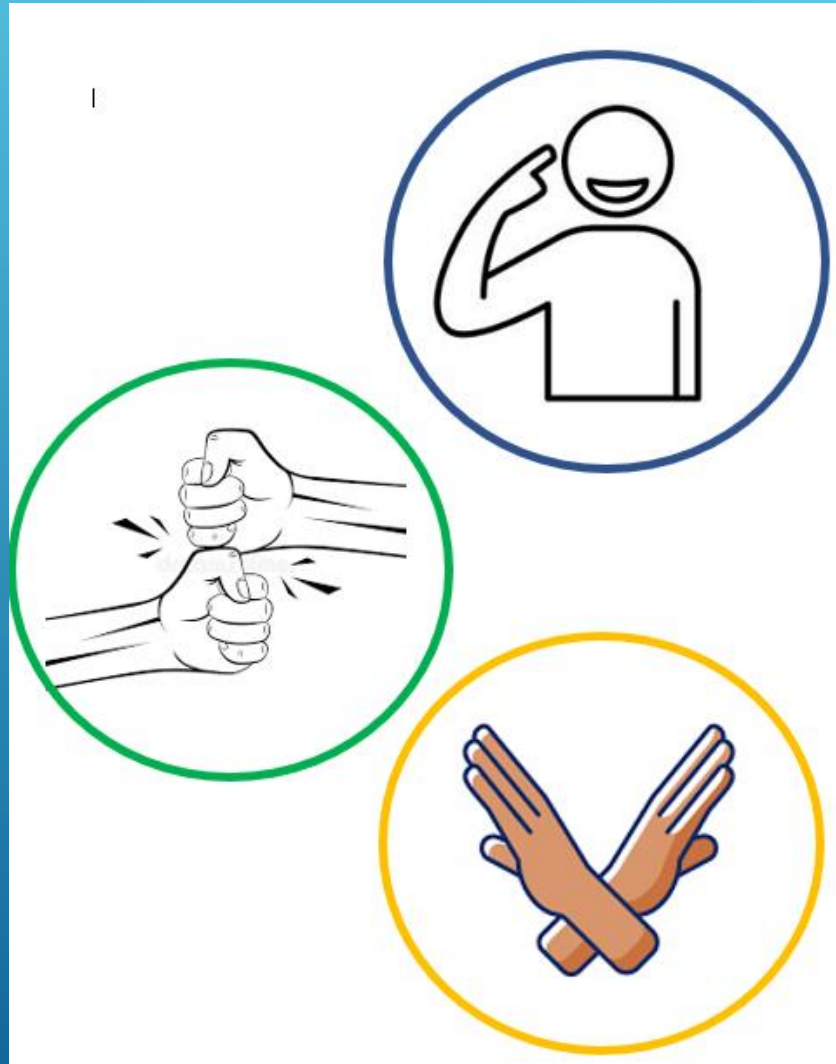
Phonics

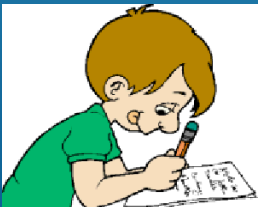

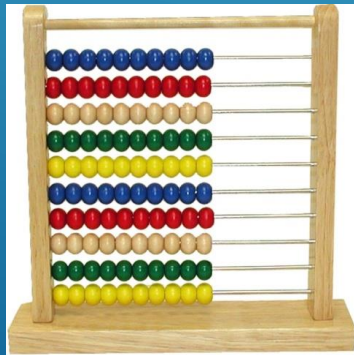

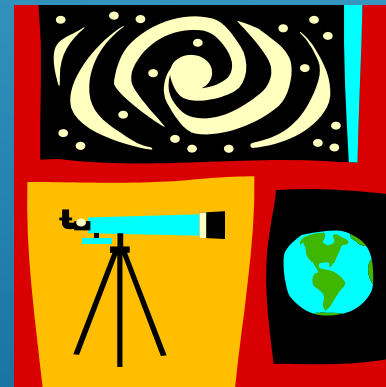
